

“HEALTH & SAFETY AUDITOR SKILLS” TRAINING OVERVIEW

The *Auditor Skills Training* session is a two-day session designed to assist prospective health and safety auditors to develop the skills needed to successfully complete a qualification audit towards AFPA Health & Safety Auditor certification.

Small Employer COR Program (SECORP) participants are also required to complete this session unless they are using an external consultant to complete their audit.

This course is offered twice a year, with one session in the spring, and one in the fall.

The two day course covers:

- Auditing fundamentals
- A breakdown of the audit process
- How to complete documentation reviews, interviews and observation tours
- How to write an audit report.

Anyone interested in becoming an AFPA Certified Auditor must attend this session within 6 months of performing a qualification audit and/or internal SECORP Audit

“OH&S ACT AND REGULATIONS TRAINING” OVERVIEW

Prospective auditors and SECORP participants will also be required to participate in a one-day OH&S Act & Regulations Training Session. This program provides detailed information on the Alberta Occupational Health & Safety Act and Regulations. This course is also offered twice a year with one session in the spring, and one in the fall.
